



## SUMMARY OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT

<b>Post:</b>	Mental Health Peer Support Worker
<b>Place of work:</b>	The post will be based at EACH Ealing, 84 Uxbridge Road, 4 <sup>th</sup> Floor, W13 8RA. Remote working may be necessary and will be required to work from any of EACH's locations.
<b>Hours of work:</b>	22.5 hours per week exclusive of 30 minutes meal breaks. The post holder may be required to work flexible hours to meet the requirements of the service.
<b>Salary Range:</b>	Salary point £27,300 - £30,095 pa (full time equivalent inclusive of Outer London Weighting). Pro-rata for 22.5 hours/week is <b>£16,380 - 18,057 per annum (inclusive of OLW)</b> .
<b>Probation:</b>	This post is subject to 6 months probationary period during which two weeks' notice by either party will apply
<b>Annual leave:</b>	25 days per annum, (pro rata for part time staff) with leave year being 12 months commencing from our start date, plus additional statutory holiday requirements. Stepped increase in annual leave from after year 2 to year 6 rising 1 day each year from 25 to 30 days in year 6. EACH normally closes down for 2 - 5 days during the Christmas period, such days will be deducted from the annual leave entitlements.
<b>Pension:</b>	On completion of 3 months of service you will be automatically enrolled to EACH's pension scheme, subject to meeting minimum salary and age requirements. You will be required to contribute a minimum of 4%, and contributions will be matched by EACH up to a maximum of 6%. You may choose to opt-out of the scheme.
<b>Contract status:</b>	This post is permanent, but is subject to performance and continuous funding.
<b>Staff development:</b>	EACH actively supports and promotes professional development in line with service requirements
<b>Smoking:</b>	EACH's premises are designated as no-smoking areas
